The aforesaid petition of Neil Deardoff et al
as recorded in Commissioners Record Page 133 being
under consideration the following action thereon was
had by the Board of Comrs of Douglas County Kansas
to wit: Upon due consideration no legal objection
having been offered against the establishment
of said road hereinafter mentioned and believing
the same to be of public utility it is ordered that
the Viewers Report of View and Report and plat
of Survey be adopted as follows to wit: Location

Begun at 85 Rods West of the SE Cor of Sec 27 T13 R19 then Variation
89° 45' E N 27° 30' E 11.00 Ch thence N 71° E 8.00 Ch thence S 81° 15' E 5.00 Ch
thence N 51° 15' E 5.00 Ch more or less to the Centre of road on the east
line of Sec 27. Said road to be 40 ft wide 20 ft on either
side of the above described line and that said road
be declared located and established as a public
highway in accordance thereof, full record to be
made in Road Record and plat as Road* and the
Trustee of Wakarusa Township be notified because the same
to be opened to public travel

Also

To vacate the following to wit: Beg at the SE Cor of said Sec 27
thence West 85 Rods more or less to the above located road.
