at the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec Cor of Secs 22 & 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ R 18 E thence S following the Sec line
as nearly as the improvements and natural obstacles will permit
 $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles to the S W Cor of Sec 26 thence E along S line of said Sec 26
80 R thence on the S side of Sec line E 80 R thence on the North
side of the Sec line E 160 R to the S E Cor of said Sec 26 also
to vacate the old road running from the crossing of Rock Creek
in a South Easterly direction to the S line of Sec 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ R 18
The Board on motion appointed as viewers on
the above road John Rediker R A Dolber and
John W Bullock and that they meet in conjunction
with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day
designated in their notice and to proceed to view and lay out the
proposed road according to law, giving to all parties a
hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the
County Board
