Beg at the SW Cor of Sec 34 Twp 12 Range 19 thence running to the SE Cor of said Sec 34 thence said road to connect the roads now located and opened running west from said SW Cor of said Sec 34 and E from said SE Cor of said Sec 34. The Board on motion appointed as viewers on the above road J. J. Wilson, Wm. Brewsterfield and Frank Thralls and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view and lay out the proposed road according to law giving all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.
