Viewers appointed on
Petition of N. J. Fluke et al
for location of Road

On the 19th day of April 1897 a road petition signed by N. J. Fluke et al was filed and on this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas praying for the location of a road described as follows. Beginning on the W. line of the SE^{1/4} of Sec 21 S 12th R 20th E. 20 feet N. of the N. line of the R. of W. of the Union Pacific R.R. Thence following said R.R. and the Leavenworth Branch parallel thereto to the South Bank of Mud Creek Thence North Westward following the S. bank of Mud Creek to an intersection with the County Road on the N. line of said Sec 21. Said petition was accompanied with a Bond as required by law signed by N. J. Fluke as principal and J. R. Suber as Surety in the sum of all expenses accruing on said view wherein said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been complied with it was ordered that A. L. Cox H. B. Richards and A. E. Owen be appointed Viewers on the proposed road and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated by their notice and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.
