Contract for Bridge } The Board on motion awarded a contract to the McVally Bridge & Iron Co for a steel bridge across Mud Creek on the line between Jefferson and Douglas Counties to replace a wooden bridge at said place now condemned as unsafe & dangerous. Said Contract being in compliance with the desire of The Board of Commissioners of Jefferson County. The amount for new bridge complete except flooring being \$750.00.
