The aforesaid petition of N.P. Flute et al  
as recorded in Town Record Page 155 being  
under consideration, the following action thereon  
was had by the Board of Commissioners of Douglas  
Co Kas., to wit: Upon due consideration no legal  
objection having been offered against the establishment  
of said road herein after mentioned and becoming  
the same to be of public utility it is ordered that the  
Lowers Report & Report & Plat of Survey be adopted  
as follows: Beg' on the W. line of SE 1/4 Sec 21 S 21 R 20 E  
at a point 20 ft N of the N line of R of W of U.P.R.R. thence N 69° E  
parallel to said R of W 15.50 ch to the junction of Leavenworth Branch  
and thence parallel to said Leavenworth Branch and 20 feet  
from the W line of Centre Sec 21 S 21 R 20 same 23.00 to end of  
curve thence 45° 40' E parallel to said R of W 51.80 ch to the S  
branch of Mud Creek thence N 74° W 5.00 ch more or less  
to intersect the Co road near the S. end of Bridge across  
Mud Creek. Said road to be 40 feet wide 20 feet  
on either side of the above described line and that  
said road be declared located and established  
as a public highway in accordance therewith  
full record to make in Road Record and plat as  
Road # and the Trustee of Grant Township be notified  
to cause the same to be opened for public travel.
