Viewers appointed
on Henshaw Road }

A petition having been received signed by Nathan Henshaw et al praying for the location of a road as follows Beg at NW cor of S $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec 6 & R 21 Eudora Jct and running on a direct line E of NW cor of S $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 5 & of R 21 to the Wakarusa River and that a bridge be constructed across said river & that said road be continued East until it connects with 7th Street in the City of Eudora, whereupon the Board appointed A. G. Walter, Charles Albright and Charles Cox as Viewers to meet with Co Surveyor at the place of beginning on Oct 12th 1897 to view proposed road and give all parties a hearing and make full report to Board of Commis.

on Ditch of 6 Acres }

A petition having been received signed by Garrison Wicks et al praying for the location of a ditch as follows, commencing about 20 rods North of the South line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec 21 & 13 R 18 then running in a Northerly direction 320 rods more or less to intersect a ditch or drain in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec 16 T 13 R 18, whereupon the Board appointed J. R. Poppaig Albert Walter and Job Martin as Viewers to meet with the Co Surveyor at the place of beginning on Oct 14th 1897 to view the proposed ditch, give all parties a hearing and make full report to the Board of Commissioners of Douglas Co to
