The aforesaid petition of James Hogue et al as recorded in Commissioners Record "4" page 151 being under consideration the following action thereon was had by the Board of Commissioners of Douglas Co Kansas to wit: Upon due consideration, no legal objection having been offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter mentioned and believing the same to be of public utility it is ordered that the Viewers Report and the Report and Plat of Survey be adopted as follows: Beginning at the S.W. corner of Sec 34 Town 12 S Range 19 E Thence East in a direct line one mile more or less to the S.E. Cor of said Sec 34, Said road to be Forty feet wide, twenty feet on either side of the above described line and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance thereof full record to be made in Road Record and Plat as Road No. and the Trustee of Wakarusa Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for public travel.
