the LeCompton Bridge

} The following resolution was introduced by Chairman Nace and on motion adopted: Resolved, that we the Commissioners of Douglas Co has having complied with the law known as a special act of the Kansas Legislature of 1897 authorizing the counties of Douglas and Jefferson to construct a bridge across the Kansas River at LeCompton do hereby notify the Commissioners of Jefferson County to deposit the money or Bonds of Jefferson Co with the Treasurer of Douglas Co in compliance with said act that we may close the Contract for building said bridge according to plans and specifications on file in this office.

Bonds of Natl Banks

} The Board on motion instructed the Clerk to notify the Lawrence Natl Bank and the Watten's Natl Bank to file new Bonds in the sum of \$150,000 each with the Co Clerk.

} The Board on motion instructed the Clerk to notify the Sheriff to release Howard Street from the Co Jail the fine and cost to remain as adjudged.

} The Board on motion appointed J. C. Peffer and M. T. Harding as Treasury Examiners for the ensuing quarter.
