Concerning taxes etc

The Board on motion adopted the following Resolution  
That Whereas, the Legislature of the year 1897 appropriated  
to Douglas County the sum of two thousand two hundred eighty five  
and  $\frac{50}{100}$  dollars (\$285 $\frac{50}{100}$ ) for the maintenance of destitute insane for  
previous years. In order to obtain this money from the State  
of Kansas the County of Douglas has first to pay the back taxes  
up to and including the year 1897 amounting to One  
thousand One hundred Sixty two and  $\frac{3}{100}$  dollars (\$162 $\frac{3}{100}$ ) before  
said sum can be obtained from the said State of Kansas  
as Douglas County has not collected these taxes it is therefore  
Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County  
Kansas that Samuel P Moore Treasurer of Douglas County is  
hereby authorized and directed to charge to the State of  
Kansas the said sum of One thousand one hundred Sixty two  
~~and  $\frac{3}{100}$~~  dollars which the State of Kansas has withheld from  
the said money due the County of Douglas for the maintenance  
of said destitute insane and credit the same to the  
Douglas County General Fund
