The Board on motion agreed to furnish Piling and lumber and to drive the Piling on crossing near Sibley. The Township of Matarusa to do all the hauling and make the fill.

Treasury Examiner

The Board on motion appointed C W Roberts and Oliver Butler as Treasury Examiners for the ensuing quarter.

petitioned for by E M Duncan et al } A petition being presented to the Board by E M Duncan et al praying for the location of the following described road to wit Beginning at a point on the E. line of Sec 14 T12S R17E 868 1/2 feet S of the N.E. Corner of said Sec 14 thence N 74° 1' W 859.8 feet thence N 79° W 151.1 feet thence N 84° 37' W 3287.2 feet thence W 379 ft to intersect the road running North & South along the W. line of N.E. 1/4 of Sec 14 T12S R17E, whereupon the Board on motion appointed R W Gorrell J J Dobler and Albert Walters as Viewers to meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning and to view the proposed road giving all parties a hearing and make full report to the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County Kas.
