Armstrong praying that the road be widened twelve feet on the south side of the following tract: The first 18 Chances in the second one half mile of Road #382 petitioned for by W. H. Armstrong now on record in the County Clerk's Office. The Board on motion appointed H. B. Bowen Peter Haste and Wm Ritzman as Viewers to meet at the place of beginning in conjunction with the County Surveyor to view said road giving all parties a hearing and to make full report to the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas
