

Lawrence Kansas Nov 6th 1899

Resolution of K. C. Topeka
and Lawrence Railway

The following Resolution was on motion adopted
to wit: Whereas, the City of Lawrence has granted a license to the Kansas
City Lawrence and Topeka Railway Company, a Corporation organized
under the laws of the State of Kansas authorizing said Railway Company upon
certain terms and conditions in Ordinance of the City of Lawrence No 398
fully set out and stated and Whereas said Railway Company to reach
the terminal points of the lines laid out in said license must travel
along certain highways in the County of Douglas outside of the City of Lawrence
now therefore Be it Resolved that Authority is hereby granted to the
said Kansas City Lawrence and Topeka Railway Company to
construct maintain and operate its railway along the County Road
No 127 being the extension of Massachusetts St south from the City
limits of the City of Lawrence to the Highway being County Road
No 127 running east and west between Teds Nos 6 and 7
in Twp 13 Range 20 in said County also commencing at the
South End of New Green Street where said street intersects Morris
Street on the Township lines between No 12 and No 13 thence east
on the highway, a continuation of Morris St to a point to be
selected by said Railway Company on the South Side of Oak
Hill Cemetery. This Grant is made on conditions that said
Railway Company shall construct operate and maintain said
railway as directed, specified in said City Ordinance, all
of the conditions of which Ordinance and Franchise unless otherwise
expressly provided for in this Resolution are referred to
and made a part of this grant. The track of said Railway
on said Road leading south from Mass St shall be laid six feet
east of the Centre line of said highway and on said highway continuing
east from Morris St shall be or as may be hereafter agreed upon
by the Board of Co Commissioners and said Railway Co along the
Centre line of said highway. The said Railway Company is to
keep and maintain the tracks along said highways graded
with the same materials that said Road is from time to time made
of and shall at all crossings where the highway crosses its
tracks keep and maintain the same in condition as required
of Railway Companies by law. Said Company shall
indicate by some distinct sign the places along said line
where passengers may get on or off its cars, the convenience
of the public to be consulted. The said Railway shall accept
this Resolution within 5 days from the date
