The Board of Commissioners of Douglas Co. 115. met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk

Present J. F. Hughes chairman B. T. Hostinson A. J. Parnell and the County Clerk Harry Dick. At the clock stroke the hour of twelve the following newly elected officers were sworn in.

J. C. Watts commissioner E. G. Myers Sheriff Geo. T. Boxman Register of Deeds H. C. Oatman corner Loyal Duffee surveyor Geo. C. Flory county clerk. The Board of county commissioners reorganizing by electing B. T. Hostinson as chairman. The Board then adjourning for dinner.

At one o'clock the County Commissioners met with those present B. T. Hostinson chairman A. J. Parnell J. C. Watts and Geo. C. Flory County Clerk. The Board accepted the proposition submitted in writing by Maggie A. Woodward to pay the sum of twenty five dollars in full payment for redemption of County interest in Lots 1 & 2 in Block 38 town of Clinton Kas. said redemption being without cost of redemption.

Resolution by J. C. Watts Whereas Chapter 25 laws of 1888 section 35. Section 47. Chapter 27 laws of Kansas 1897 provides: "The board of County Commissioners shall cause to be published a statement, at the close of every regular or special meeting, of all sums of money allowed, for what purpose; said statement to be published once in some paper of general circulation in the county.

Therefore, be it resolved by this board: that the Clerk thereof be and he is instructed, to keep a true & correct account of all claims by this board allowed, & to whom allowed, & for what purpose allowed, & the Clerk of this board is hereby authorized & instructed, to cause a statement thereof to be published in the official paper of this County, once immediately after the regular or special meeting at which said sum of money is allowed
