city of Lawrence, and to protect the public health. That the Board of
County Commissioners hereby authorize the Sheriff of this County
to co-operate with the City Marshall of the City of Lawrence in providing
proper accommodations, guards and care for such persons as may be now
confined or hereafter be confined in the city or county jails who may be
sick or infected with said disease and that the County equally share
the expense thereby incurred with the City of Lawrence.
