The Township Assessors of Douglas County Kansas, met at the Court house on Monday March 5th 1900 for the purpose of making a basis of valuation for the year 1900. J. R. Woodward was elected chairman & S. E. Carleton sec. - On motion it was agreed to assess all personal property at full value deduct The constitutional exemption \$200⁰⁰ & divide The remainder by Three & take The result for The assessment.
