Board of Health J. C. Watts was elected Chairman of The Board of Health.

Board of Health Moved & seconded That The sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) be appropriated for County institute fund, carried by unanimous vote.

Board of Health On Motion of Mr. Watts That The Lawrence Construction Co. pay to The County Treasurer of Douglas County The sum of \$1000.00 and That They give The County a good & sufficient bond in some company to be approved by The County Attorney of Douglas County Kansas in the sum of \$4,200.00 for The faithful performance of The agreement between The Lawrence Construction Co. & The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County dated Nov. 16th 1899 & That the provision of said proposition that There shall be built completed & put in operation ten miles of said railway mentioned therein within one year from 15th day of Nov. 1899 & ten miles additional within two years from That day shall be modified to take effect within one & two years respectively from This date April 3rd 1900.
