

Lawrence Kansas April 4-1901

The Hon. Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment with those present as follows B. T. Hutchinson Ch. A. J. Parcell J. C. Walls and Geo. A. Stay Esq. Clerk.

^{County Printing} The Jeffersonian Gazette presented to the Board a written offer to publish all or any part of the legal printing of the County during the year of 1900 at the following rates. Tax lists & final tax notices at the legal rates as prescribed by law & collected by the County Treasurer from the delinquent tax payers. Road notices, Sheriff's proclamation & all other legal advertising at half legal rates. Commissioners proceedings & reports of bills at one cent per line

Moved by A. J. Parcell that the Lawrence Weekly World be made the official County paper for the ensuing year ending first Monday in January 1901 provided further the cost of publishing Commissioners proceedings & bills shall not exceed one cent per line

Moved by J. C. Walls to amend that the Jeffersonian Gazette be made the official County paper for reasons that we have a written proposition by which he agrees to do County printing for half legal rates on all work except concerning Treasurer's Office which is provided for by law & further agrees to publish the monthly bills allowed by the Commissioners at each regular meeting for one cent per line.

Moved by B. T. Hutchinson an amendment to amendment that the Lawrence Journal be made the official County paper, provided that cost of publishing Commissioners proceedings shall not exceed one cent per line.

The vote was as follows A. J. Parcell and J. C. Walls voted against the amendment to amendment, and B. T. Hutchinson voting for the amendment to amendment. The first amendment as offered by J. C. Walls was taken up and voted on as follows J. C. Walls voting for
and B. T. Hutchinson and A. J. Parcell voting against

The original motion of A. J. Parcell was taken up & voted on as follows
A. J. Parcell voting for
J. C. Walls & B. T. Hutchinson voting against

On Motion a Ballot was taken the Lawrence Journal receiving two votes and the Lawrence World receiving one vote
There being a majority of the votes cast for the Lawrence Journal it was thereby declared the official County paper for the ensuing year

The Slaters road case came up for hearing before the Board & after giving all parties a hearing the Slaters Road Bd. granted the road as petitioned for & damages awarded according to the report of the viewers to Wm. L. Mueller for the sum of \$65.00.
