Hook came before The Board asking for the release from the County Jail of one Dr. Myers who was convicted March 29 - 1900 on the charge of willfully disturbing the peace as charged in the complaint. County Atty. W. B. Brownell came before The Board & argued against the aforesaid release of one Dr. Myers. Moved by J. C. Watts that said Dr. Myers be released from jail on April 25th 1900. No farther action taken.
