Dollars into the Treasury of Douglas County by said company & the payment of
the costs in said actions, said actions to be dismissed with prejudice.
And the County Atty is hereby authorized to carry out said settlement, and the
County Treasurer is hereby authorized to accept said sum.

Treasurer } 1879 on a valuation of \$67,500⁰⁰ a tax amounting to the sum of \$4250⁰⁰
In motion of Mr. Watts & seconded by Mr. Russell it was ordered that the
County Treasurer be instructed to receive in full payment of said taxes
for the year 1879 the sum of \$1700⁰⁰ and the balance of taxes & penalties
are to be cancelled, & said Treasurer is hereby authorized to take credit for said
cancelled taxes & penalties. Motion carried by Mr. Watts & Mr. Russell
voting for. Mr. Hostinow not voting.
