Petition of J. L. Adams

A petition filed by Signed by J. L. Adams
and 4 others was presented to the Board asking for
Location & construction of a certain ditch in
Grant Township. Described and apportioned as
follows

Beginning in the NW 1/4 of Section 20 Township 12.
Range 20 at about 60 Rods South of the North line and
about 60 Rods West of the E. line of said quarter. More or less
thence in a northerly direction to the North line of said 1/4 sec
thence in a North easterly direction to a point about 65 Rods
