A petition signed by Gus Bahnmaier and 15 others praying for the location and establishment of a certain road described as follows Beginning at the S-E-corner of the S-W-1/4 of sec -6-T-12-R-18- thence N-and-W- following the private road to the N-line of S-1/2 of S-W-1/4 of sec -6-12-18- to the W-line of said 1/4 sec the above road to be 40 feet or less and not to interfere with any fence or permanent improvements of any kind now located on the S-1/2 of the S-W-1/4 of sec -6-12-18- Thence W- through the S-E-1/4 of sec-7-12-18- at a point about 70 ft to the S-line of the S-W-1/4 fractional of sec -7-12-18 thence W- on sec-line as near as practicable to the S-W-corner of -E-1/2 of -S-E-1/4 of sec -12-12-17- to the intersection of Leocompton and Topeka road

Also commencing at the N-E-corner of sec -13-12-17- thence S-about -160- ft to the intersection of Lawrence and Topeka road
