th south 61°15' west 176 ft th north 83° West 563 ft th north 1° East 515 ft
to a point on north line of sec -24- Th west on section line to intersect
county road at the 1/4 cor between sections -13-and 24- width of roadway 40
ft Land for same having been Dedicated by Deskins et al
