Gentlemen:-

On the 11th inst, you requested our opinion upon the following propositions to wit:

First: Has the County Attorney authority to employ an assistant at the expense of the County without the authority of the Board of County Commissioners?
Second: Where the Co Attorney transacts legal business for the County out side of his County what fees is he intitled to for such services, and, is he intitled to pay for work done in the County in cases pending in courts out side of the County in which the County is interested, for instance, the preparation of a brief in his County for use in a case pending in another County
Third: Is the County responsible for costs in criminal cases where a conviction is not secured
