Application of D R.Nelson et al

for franchise to construct an electric line through Co

Where upon the application of D.R.Nelson J.B.Adams H.M.Levan and T.S.Salathiel for franchise and right of way along the public roads to construct maintain and operate an electric street rail way From Rudora to Lawrence and from Lawrence to Shawnee County line Being under consideration, it was voted by Mr J.C.Watts and carried by a unanimous vote that the following petition be granted as submitted, of which the following is a copy

Section 1

Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas That D.R.Nelson J.B.Adams H.M.Levan and T.S.Salathiel from themselves their Successors and assigns who shall hereafter grant be known as grantees, be and they are hereby are granted the right to locate, construct, and equip, maintain and operate for the period of (50) fifty years from the date hereof, an Electric Street Railway with single track and the necessary switches, Turnouts, side tracks, Tunnels, Poles wires cables, electrical and mechanical appliances and Appurtenances for the Construction equipment and operation
