Assessors Meeting

Lawrence Kansas Monday March-3-1902

The Township assessors of Douglas County Kansas met at the County Clerk's office for the purpose of making a basis of valuation of Real Estate and personal property - Real Estate property to be assessed at one fourth its value

Personal property at one third its value - The following schedule was adopted

Horses - 1 year old - 15⁰⁰ - 2 year old 20⁰⁰ - Three year old 30⁰⁰ four to nine year old 35⁰⁰ to 100⁰⁰ Nine year old and over 55⁰⁰ to 50⁰⁰
Cattle - one year old 8⁰⁰ to 12⁰⁰ Two year old 15⁰⁰ to 20⁰⁰ Three year old 20⁰⁰ Fat Cattle 3- to 5¢ per lb - Cows 20⁰⁰ to 50⁰⁰ - Bulls 30⁰⁰ to 60⁰⁰
Sheep and Goats 2⁰⁰ to 3⁰⁰ Hogs 4¢ per lb Farm implements to at full value - Wagons Carriages and Gold watches at full value Silver watches 5⁰⁰ to 10⁰⁰ - Pianos 25⁰⁰ to 300⁰⁰ Other Musical instruments at full value - Schedules from - 10 to 20 - at full value

Grain - Hay 25¢ per ton Corn 50¢ to 60¢ per bu wheat 60¢ per bu Oats 40¢ Flax 125¢ per bu Other grain at full value - Seed 1⁰⁰ per ton

Schedule - 22 to 23 at full value - Valued to take out exemption of 200⁰⁰ Then divide by 3 remainder to be amount subject to tax
