In the Matter of Deed of J. B. Watkins
for Court House Site.

Whereas Gabry B. Watkins of Lawrence Kansas has this day by Deed of General Warranty Conveyed to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County for the use and benefit of Douglas County Certain lots described as Nos Nine (9) Eleven (11) Thirteen (13) and fifteen (15) in the City of Lawrence known as park lots

Be it resolved that the buildings now upon said lots and the Brick sidewalks and other improvements thereon do not pass by said deed, but remain the property of said Gabry B. Watkins. Said buildings and improvements to be removed by said Watkins at his own expense before said ground shall be needed by the County to prepare for the County Buildings and the out side sidewalks to remain in position until they are ordered moved by the Board of County Commissioners of said County

And it is further understood and agreed that the said J. B. Watkins reserves the right to enter upon said property to protect his property thereon and remove the same therefrom

Said deed which is delivered this 19th day of March - 1902 is accepted by the Board of County Commissioners upon the terms and conditions expressed in said deed
