In pursuance of your advertisement for a site for a public building for Lawrence Kansas, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County beg leave to offer a piece of ground on the corner of Main and Pine Street 150 x 150 ft for the sum of \$2000⁰⁰ Two Thousand Dollars. This location would be Central between North & South Lawrence, is on the main street of the City and is only one block from the present location of the P. O., it is about equally distant from each of two depots and is about 1500 feet from each. The location is on the Bank of the Kansas River and an open site. A plat is herewith submitted
