Clerk has authorized to notify the Lawrence Journal The Lawrence World and The Jeffersonian Gazette of Number of Ballots required for November Election and receive bids for ~~same~~ printing same from as many of said Companies as desire to submit bids for same and the County Clerk is hereby authorized to award Contract for same to the lowest responsible bidder

In pursuance of an Order of the Board of Commissioners made on Oct. 9th authorizing the Co. Clerk to notify the different News Paper Establishment of the Number of Ballots required for Nov. Election and receive bids and award Contract to lowest Responsible Bidder, Where upon the Lawrence Journal The Lawrence World offers to do the furnish 16900 General Ballots 16900 Constitutional Amendment Ballots and 9450 Township Ballots for the sum of \$163.⁰⁰ and 162.⁰⁰ respectively The Lawrence World being the lowest bidder I then awarded Contract to said Lawrence World
