

In the Matter of the E. J. Herschell Road Case.

Upon presentation of a petition signed by E. J. Herschell and eighteen others, asking for the location of a certain proposed road, described as follows to wit: Beginning at N.E. cor. of N² of N.E. of sec. 12-17-17, th N. on sec. line as near the sec. line as a practical highway can be made, to the sec. cor. of sec. 2nd 3rd sec. 10th 11, T. 12-R. 17. Then upon the following viewers were appointed: Asgood Coleman, L. H. Telford and A. C. Walters, to meet in conjunction with the Co. Surveyor at place of beginning of said proposed road, on Friday Jan 30, 1903.

O. P. Thompson road case

The Board on motion accepted said road to be used for road purposes being dedicated to Douglas County by O. P. Thompson and others to wit: Beginning at a point on county road between sections 11-12 - township 12 - Range 17 where the county road leaves sec. line to the West, th N. on sec. line to a point where the county road leaves the sec. line. Between sections 11-12 in township 12 - Range 17 and bears East into sec. 12-17-17. Said line to be used as a public highway. The road between said points off the sec. line is hereby vacated.

On motion the board adjourned until Jan. 6 - 1903
