Sealed proposals will be received by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County ^{with the cooperation of} Court House at Lawrence, Kansas, until twelve o'clock on the eighteenth day of February 1903. Also at the same time and place, proposals for heating, plumbing and gas-fitting in the new Court House building.

Plans and specifications for the above may be seen at the office of the County Clerk. Each proposal will be accompanied by a check certified to by the president or cashier of some bank upon which it is drawn to the ^{said} Board of County Commissioners for a sum not less than two per cent of the amount of the proposal, and payable to J. W. Lewis, Treasurer of Douglas County, which will be forfeited to the County as damages sustained, if the bidder fails for five days to sign contract and give satisfactory bond in case award is made to him.

Attention of bidders is called to the laws regulating the hours of labor.

Bids will conform to forms found attached to specifications which forms for use may be had on application to the County Clerk.

Bids will be sealed and endorsed on outside of envelopes with name or names of bidders together with the nature of the parts bid upon viz: "Construction" or "Heating", "Plumbing" or "Gas-fitting", and will be addressed to Geo.
