Opened bids for Court House.

First bid opened was Rawls and Bailey. Form of proposal for the construction of the new Douglas County Court House at Lawrence, Kansas.

Notice to Contractors.

Sealed proposals on blank forms will be received by the Board of County Commissioners until 12 o'clock on the eighteenth day of Feb. 1903. at which time all the bids must be on file with the County Clerk as follows:

1st. For General Construction.

2nd. For Heating, plumbing and gas-fitting.

Bidders will observe the above classification and file separate proposals with guarantee for each class. Bids for general construction will not include the other classes.

Bids for heating, plumbing and gas fitting must be from parties engaged in these branches of construction.

Attention is called to the Statutes limiting the hours of labor.

Ninety percent of the value of labor and materials delivered on the grounds properly housed and protected will be paid each month as nearly as the progress of the work will justify.

Samples of all building stone, rubble, ashlar and dressing with brick and slate, will be furnished and will be distinctly marked with name of the bidder and purpose intended, and filed with the County Clerk with bids for the work.
