I will add or deduct excavation at
the rate of 25 cts. per cubic yard.

I will add or deduct concrete
foundations at the rate of 19 cts. per cubic foot.

I will add or deduct Rubble Masonry at
the rate of 15 cts. per cubic foot.

I will add or deduct ashlar facings of
Douglas or Jefferson County stone at the rate of
50 cts. per superficial foot.

I will add one foot to the exterior height
of the basement story leaving floor of basement
where it now is, adding twelve inches to ashlar
facings, twelve inches to height of glass in
windows, for the sum of * and properly
adjust approaches to the added height.

I will make basement window sills into
a full continuous course around the building and
ten inches thick, with the same exposure above ground
as now shown and add *

I will add or deduct plastering at the
rate of 25 cts. per square yard.

I will execute the plastering in any of
the accepted cements as directed by the local
architect, including fiber, hair and finish and
will add or deduct — cents per square yard,
this to take the place of the lime mortar specified.

I will add or deduct brick work measured
at the rate of twenty bricks to the cubic foot at
* 12⁰⁰ per 1000 brick.

In case award is made to me I will
deliver on the site, or wherever the local architect
directs, all timber for finish floors from clear,
heart, rift sawed, long leafed, hard pine of dimensions
1 x 4 in the rough stacked with lath between all
boards, housed and protected as directed, all
within 90 days from date of award, and 12⁰⁰
months before use. I will place all this floor
lumber in a good dry kiln, and keep it there
one month when it shall be milled and laid (not
more than ninety days allowed on this proposal).
