Contract.

Agreement, Entered into at Lawrence, Kansas, this fourth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and three (1903) by and between R. F. Haskinson, J. C. Watts and A. V. Russell, County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas for and on behalf of said County, party of the first part, and George Savage of Lawrence, Kansas party of the second part.

Witnesseth, that the said party of the second part, in consideration of the agreements herein made and the fulfillment thereof by the said party of the first part, agrees with the said party of the first part as follows:

First. The said party of the second part, under the direction and to the satisfaction of J. H. Haskell and Fred. C. Gunn, associate architects, (and in the event that said architects should disagree as to the plans, then under the direction and to the satisfaction of the Board of County
