The Hon. Board of County Commissioners met in regular session with the following members present: B. F. Hoskinsen, Chairman, A. J. Carrell, & J. C. Watts, & Geo. A. Story, Co. Clerk.

Claims Allowed }

On motion Board examined & allowed claims against the county (See Allowance Record R.)

Tax Cancelled }

On motion the Co. Treasurer was ordered to cancel tax on lot 56 Kentucky St. amt. of 41st, Tax of 1866. Sale of 1857.

In the Matter of J. J. Morrison Road }

A petition signed by J. J. Morrison ^{and 37 others} asking for location & establishment of a certain proposed road described as follows: Beginning at NE cor. of sec. 33-14-20 th N along N sec. line of sec. 33-14-20 to NW cor. of said sec 33-14-20. Said road to be one mile long & the dividing line between secs 28 & 33-14-20; also that road beginning at SE cor. of J. J. Morrison's land (807) & running in N westerly direction through sec. 33 to sec. line between secs. 28 & 33-14-20 be vacated in so far as it lies in sec. 33-14-20. Whereupon the following viewers were appointed: S. E. Carlson, N. H. Gill, & J. A. Robinson who are to meet in conjunction with the Co. Surveyor on May 25-1903 at the place of beginning of said proposed road and lay out said proposed road according to law giving to all parties a hearing & make due reports of their proceedings to County Board.

In the Matter of John Ott Road }

A petition signed by John Ott & 21 others asking for location & establishment of a certain proposed road described as follows: Beginning at a point on the E sec. line of sec 12-13-20 where said E sec. line intersects the road running E & N. Th. N to center of said sec. 12. Th E 80 rods, Th N 120 rods to intersect road # 81 Th. N along said road 170 rods, Th E 160 rods to intersect road petitioned for by Nathan Newkirk now on file in the office of County Clerk, Douglas.
