In the matter of Great Prop. Levee Petition }

A petition signed by W. C. Ross ^{and} 35 others asking for location ^{and} establishment of a certain proposed levee described as follows: Commence at a point about 50 R N of Jacob Purdy's house th. up the Kans. River in a NW direction about 36 R all in the 16th sec. 13-12-19, Great Prop. Whereupon the following viewers were appointed: W. E. Stone, John Diocelbiss ^{and} Frank Pross, who are to meet in conjunction with the Co. Surveyor on May. 14-1903 at the place of beginning of said proposed levee ^{and} lay out said proposed levee according to law, giving to all parties a hearing ^{and} make due report of their proceedings to County Board.

Brachsen ^{and} 24 others asking for location ^{and} establishment of a certain proposed road described as follows: Beginning at NE cor. of sec. 28 ^{and} on the SE cor. of sec. 21, th N along sec. line (or as near same as practicable) between sec. 28 ^{and} 29 on S side ^{and} sec 21 ^{and} 20 on N side to NW cor. of sec. 20 ^{and} 29 all in Twp. 14 - Range 21, Palmyra Twp.
