

In the matter of Dirty Road

A petition signed by Mr. August Ditz and 27 others asking for location and establishment of a certain proposed road described as follows: Begin at SW cor. of NW⁴ sec. 8 in Willow Springs Twp. Douglas County, Mo. to run therefrom due N as near as practicable to make a good road between Geo. W. Barton's farm on the W and the Dalbee and Ross farms on the E between sec. 5 and 6 to the Clinton Twp. line.

Whereupon the following viewers were appointed: J. D. Moore, Ira Rockrock and O. A. Coleman, who are to meet in conjunction with the Co. Surveyor on Mon. June 8-1903 at the place of beginning of said proposed road and lay out said proposed road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to County Board.
