Publication in the Matter of
Lawrence Bridge Etc.

The Co. Clerk was ordered to send the following publication notice to The Kansas City Star, Kansas City Journal, Lawrence Journal, Lawrence World and Lawrence Gazette.

Publication Notice: Notice is hereby given, that the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas will receive sealed proposals at his office up until July 15th - 1903 at 12 o'clock M. for making the fill and constructing the embankments on Bridge Street, at the North end of the Bridge which crosses the Kansas river in the city of Lawrence, Kansas, said fill and construction of embankments to be made according to plans and specifications now on file in the office of said clerk.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check of five hundred dollars (\$500) on some Lawrence Bank payable to John W. James, County Treasurer of Douglas County Kansas, same to be forfeited in case successful bidder fails to enter into contract within five days from date of acceptance.

The right to accept or reject any or all bids is hereby reserved.
