Contract.

Articles of agreement made this 27th day of August in the year of our Lord, 1903 between A. J. Tullock, Proprietor Missouri Valley Bridge and Iron Works of Leavenworth Kansas, party of the first part and The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co. Kansas party of the second part. Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part for the consideration hereinafter mentioned, agrees to furnish all new material necessary and to build and construct for the said party of the second part, a Bridge across the Wakarusa River at Eudora and have the same completed on or before the 27th day of January, 1904.

Said Bridge to be completed in accordance with the plan and specification hereunto attached, which are hereby made a part of this contract.
