

Lawrence, Kansas Sept. 12 - 1903

The Hon. Board of Co. Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with the following members present: A. J. Parrell, chairman, J. C. Maitland, Secy & Story, Co. Clerk.

In the matter of W. W. Cockins Road }

On motion of Mr. Maitland viewers report of view<sup>ers</sup> and surveyors plot of survey were accepted.

In the matter of road as petitioned for by W. W. Cockins & others being recorded on page 536 Volume 6. Com. record. Being under consideration the following action was had thereon by Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, to-wit: No legal objections having been offered against establishment of said proposed road herein after mentioned and believing same to be a public utility it is ordered that viewers report of view<sup>ers</sup> and report of plot of survey be adopted as follows: Location to-wit: Beginning on W line of sec. 18 T12 R20 1667 ft. S of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. on W line of NW of sec. 18 th  $87^{\circ} 55' E$  350 ft. th  $87^{\circ} 25' E$  340 ft. th  $86^{\circ} 15' E$  355 ft. th  $59^{\circ} 47' E$  100 ft. th  $164^{\circ} 00'$  to intersect road on S line of sec. 18 T12 R20. And that said road be declared located and established as a public highway. Damages were awarded as follows:
