H. A. Davidson Road Case

In the matter of road as petitioned for by H. A. Davidson and eleven others being recorded on page 532, Volume 2, Com. Record. Being under consideration the following action was had therein by the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, to wit: No legal objection having been offered against establishment of said proposed road here-in-after mentioned and believing same to be a public utility it is ordered that viewers report of view and report of plat of survey be adopted as follows. Location to wit: Beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. on the N line of sec. 5-12, S Range 18 E. T. 1166 ft. th S $32^{\circ} 29' W$ 1066 ft. th S $1^{\circ} 12' E$ 146 ft. th S $13^{\circ} 23' E$ 222 ft. th S 1166 ft. th N $\frac{1}{4}$ mile, th $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, th W $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to NW cor. of sec. 5-12 S of R. 18 E. And that said road be declared located and established as a public highway. Damages were awarded as follows: J. M. Strick Owner NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 12-18-20. and the clerk is hereby instructed to draw warrants for same.
