{ Joint Session Between Douglas & Leavenworth Counties }
 Transcript from Record of Com.
 Journal of Leavenworth County

Be it remembered that at a session of the Board of County Commissioners of Leavenworth County, Kansas, held August 3rd, 1903, among other proceedings then and there held was the following entered of Record to wit: On motion of Comm. Neher Comm. Bleakley was authorized to take charge of Leavenworth County's interest, in connection with rebuilding bridge across Kansas River and that he be empowered to have plans and specifications prepared, receive bids, and award contracts to the lowest bidder for said bridges.

On motion of Mr. Bleakley it is ordered by unanimous vote that there be prepared definite plans and specifications to rebuild a bridge across the Kansas River at Endora, Kansas, in accordance with Chap. 16 Special Session Laws of 1903
