

Lawrence, Kansas, Feb. 3-1904

The Joint Board of County Commissioners of Douglas <sup>and</sup> Leavenworth counties met subject to call of chairmanship with the following members present: A. J. Parnell, chairman, J. C. Watts, B. F. Hoskinson, of Douglas Co. J. Bleakley representing County Board of Leavenworth Co. <sup>and</sup> Geo. A. Flory, Clerk of Joint Board.

On motion of B. F. Hoskinson, seconded by Mr. Bleakley the plans <sup>and</sup> specifications for the construction of the Kansas river bridge at Eudora as amended were approved <sup>and</sup> adopted, <sup>and</sup> contract entered into, for the construction of said bridge with A. J. Pullock, proprietor of Mo. Valley Bridge <sup>and</sup> Iron Works to be constructed according to said amended plans <sup>and</sup> specifications. Douglas <sup>and</sup> Leavenworth counties to pay \$10,000<sup>00</sup> each as provided by Special Act of the Legislature for the completion of said bridge. The two counties above mentioned agree jointly to pay for whatever additional expense may be incurred in making the approach across the island <sup>and</sup> including the approaches at the North <sup>and</sup> South banks of River. It was agreed that Mr. Bleakley act for Leavenworth County <sup>and</sup> Mr. Hoskinson for Douglas County <sup>and</sup> in their absence, Mr. Chas. Lottholz act for them.

On motion the Joint Board adjourned  
subject to call of Chairman.
