On motion of Mr. Watts Bids were opened which were as follows:

Bid of Geo. W. Savage }

Geo. W. Savage offers to construct drain according to plans and specifications on file. Tile drain 3300 ft. of 15 in. Drain for \$393⁴⁰, for Rubble stone work 18¢ sq. ft. for Rip-rap work .08¢ sq. ft. for posts and wire \$12⁰⁰. For excavation in connection with stone work 30¢ per cu. yd., for back-water valve of Iron 16 in. internal diameter 1/2 in thick 2 ft. long with leveled end and hinged door \$20⁰⁰. Same as above with wood body \$3⁰⁰. Check enclosed \$100⁰⁰.

Bid of E. Huddleston }

E. Huddleston offers to construct drain according to specifications as follows: 3300 ft. Tile Drain \$3460⁰⁰ for Rubble stone work 20¢ per cu. ft. for Rip-rap 10¢ per sq. ft., for posts wire \$15⁰⁰, for excavation for stone work 28¢ per cu. yd., for back-water valve of cast iron \$25⁰⁰ if sewer pipe \$5⁰⁰, if concrete cement \$10⁰⁰. Check enclosed \$100⁰⁰.
