The Hon. Board of Co. Commissioners met in special session at call of chairman at which were present, A. J. Farnell chairman, J. C. Natus, B. B. Hoskinson and Gust Flory, Clerk.

Resolution } On motion of Mr. Natus the following was adopted by unanimous vote: The Board ~~unanimously~~ unanimously voted to rescind action of March 9-1903 making it the duty of the County Clerk to purchase stamps and supplies for the several county officers. Same to take effect at once.

Bond Resolution } Resolution.
To Issue \$50,000 "Douglas County Bridge Bonds".
Whereas on the 24th day of December the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, passed a resolution to issue Fifty Thousand (\$50,000) Dollars Bonds of the said County to pay for the repairing and construction of Bridges in said County, and, Whereas, the date of said bonds was not fixed on the form of the bond adopted, now, therefore,
Be It Resolved, by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas that Fifty Thousand (\$50,000) Dollars, "Douglas County Bridge Bonds" be issued; Said bonds shall be dated January 1st, 1904, and payable Twenty (20) years after their date; shall be Five Hundred (\$500) in number, numbered from One (1) to Five Hundred (\$500) inclusive. Be It Further Resolved, that the said bonds, and the coupons there-to attached shall be in substantially the following forms, to-wit:
