The Jeffersonian-Gazette was then declared to be elected the Official Co. paper. Same to take effect Monday, Jan. 11-1904 ending second Monday in Jan. 1905.

Board Resolution } Resolutions With Reference to Douglas County Bridge Bonds.
 Whereas, On the 24th day of December, 1903, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, passed a resolution to issue Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollar Bonds of said County to pay for the repairing and construction of bridges in said county, and,
 Whereas, from an examination of the Commissioners Record and the papers on file concerning the construction of said bridges for which the issue of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollar Bonds, under resolution of the 24th day of December, 1903, was made, shows that the filing of plans, specifications and the adoption of the same was not done and performed as contemplated by Chapter 15, Special Session of the Kansas Legislature of 1903, excepting the contract executed August 27th 1903, made with the Missouri Valley Bridge and Iron Works Company, for Thirty-six Thousand Five hundred (\$36,500.00) Dollars, for the making of the fill at the North end of the Bridge, across the Kansas River at Lawrence, Kansas, in which case plans and specifications were properly filed and approved by the Board, and legal notice given as to the time of receiving
