

Refunding Bonds of One Thousand (\$1000.) Dollars each, numbered from One (1) to Twenty-seven (27) inclusive, dated the First day of January, 1904, and payable the First day of January, 1924, bearing interest evidenced by Coupons attached at the rate of Four and One-half per centum per annum, payable semi-annually on the First days of July and January in each year. Both principal and interest of the said Bonds to be made payable at the Fiscal Agency of the State of Kansas, in the City and State of New York.

Section V. That the Bonds and Coupons thereto attached shall be in substantially the following forms, to wit:

Know all Men By These Presents: That the County of Douglas, in the State of Kansas acknowledges to owe by for value received promises to pay to bearer, One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars lawful money of the United States of America on the First day of January A.D., 1924 with interest thereon from the date hereof until paid, at the rate of Four and one-half (4½) per centum per annum, payable semi-annually on the First days of July and January in each year upon presentation and surrender of the annexed interest coupons as they severally become due. Both principal and interest of this Bond are payable at the Fiscal Agency of the State of Kansas, in the City and State of New York. And for the prompt payment of this Bond and the interest thereon at maturity, the full faith, credit and resources of the said County are hereby irrevocably pledged.

This Bond is one of a series of Twenty Seven (27) Bonds of like date, maturity and tenor, numbered from One (1) to Twenty Seven (27) inclusive, issued by said County for the purpose of refunding a like amount of the outstanding bonded indebtedness heretofore legally created by said County and which has been outstanding over two years, and is issued under and by
