Metal Furniture Contract.

On motion of B. D. Hoskinson, seconded by J. C. Mann, it was agreed to enter into contract with the Art Metal Construction Co. of St. Louis, Mo. to furnish metal furniture for Court House vaults and such offices as are provided for in contract, for the sum of \$8500.00 which contract is as follows:

This agreement in duplicate made this 8th day of March, 1904 between Art Metal Construction Co., (a corporation organized under the laws of New York with principal office at Jamestown, New York.) party of the first part, and Douglas County, Kansas, by Board of County Commissioners of the second part.

Witnesseth: That for a consideration hereinafter named, the party of the first part agrees to furnish and deliver to said party of the second part at Lawrence, Kansas, placed in position in New Court House Building, ready for use on or before November 1st, 1904 (subject to delays caused by strikes, differences with workmen, accident at mill, inability to obtain accurate measurements and data, or other contingencies beyond the control of the party of the first part, the several articles described in the accompanying plans and specifications, which are hereby made a part of this contract.

The party of the second part agrees to pay to said party of the first part the sum of Eight Thousand Five Hundred Dollars in good and lawful money of the United States (New York
