Kans to wit: No legal objections having been offered against establishment of said proposed here-in-after mentioned and believing same to be a public utility it is ordered that viewers report of view and report of plat of survey be adopted as follows: Beginning at the SW cor. of sec. 36, Twp 13 Range 20, thence due N 1 mile between sections 36 and 36, 13-20 to NW cor. of sec. 36-13-20, and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway. Damages were awarded as follows: Amount claimed by M. H. Lightfield 300⁰⁰, amount awarded \$130⁰⁰ and the clerk is hereby instructed to draw warrant for same.
