A petition signed by E. J. Hill ^{beginning} & 17 others asking for location ^{beginning} & vacation of a certain proposed road described as follows: ^{beginning} on the N side of A. P. & B. RR Right of way. And on E line of sec. 30-11-18 to W along N side of A. P. & B. RR Right of way through sec. 30-11-18 to W line of sec. 30-11-18 th S on W line of sec. 30-11-18 to E. cor. of sec. 30-11-18. Also to vacate road on S side of A. P. & B. RR from E line of sec. 30-11-18 to W $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. on S line of sec. 30-11-18. Whereupon the Board of County Commissioners decided to act as viewers to meet in conjunction with Co. Surveyor on May 6th. 1904 at place of beginning of said proposed road ^{and} lay out said proposed road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing.
